



S.O.S LANGUAGE

Free intensive Italian L2 and active citizenship courses for refugees from Ukraine

"Language is the rudder of a ship. It is the compass without which it is not possible to chart a course. "

Premise

The courses were activated in order to provide support for private families who offer accommodation to Ukrainian refugees in their homes as part of the UMN - UnionMigrantNet and Cities Together for Integration project.

With this in mind, it was decided to take advantage of the collaboration and support of various actors active in the area: the Municipality of Trieste, CISL FVG and IAL FVG, proposing a didactic structure of training interventions that was not set at a desk, but developed according to needs, trying to respond to the educational and training needs that emerged from the analysis of the context.

Specific goals

- knowing how to use language in colloquial forms;
- knowing how to understand words, sentences and short functional texts;
- being able to use basic structures and know vocabulary related to the communicative domains of everyday life;
- being able to find one's way around the territory through the use of the language, concretely experiencing the services and opportunities offered by the city.

Target

20/40 Ukrainian citizens on the run, in a state of emergency, outside the territorial reception circuit and guests in private households, lacking basic knowledge of the Italian language and knowledge of the regulatory rules of the Italian State and local services.

Classrooms and tools

Multimedia laboratory (IWB), textbooks, tickets to reach the city, didactic material (complete folder). Part of the citizenship training will be carried out on the territory, coming into contact with the services and available areas of the city (gardens, neighborhoods, useful services, pharmacies, hospitals).



Course structuring

The course will be structured on two perspectives:

- achievement of the A1 level of Italian: it is the phase of the "first emergency" to which it is necessary to respond quickly;
- use of functional Italian: on the basis of which the linguistic bases will be provided to navigate within the variety of local services; a prompt linguistic intervention to satisfy the primary need to communicate with the reference context.

The course will be held by certified teachers on L2 teaching who will be supported by the support of native Ukrainian language / cultural mediators. The teaching methodology will be differentiated according to the target audience (adults, children and school-age children). At the end of the course, the recipients will be able to use the Italian language in everyday life to express needs and requests, understand requests and indications, understand and use familiar everyday expressions and very common formulas to satisfy needs of a concrete type.

Composition of the working group: ANOLF and IAL

- Italian language and culture teacher specialized in L2 teaching (50 hours)
- Professor of active citizenship and cultural linguistic mediator (20 hours)
- Tutor of the path of a Ukrainian native speaker (20 hours)

Duration

70 hours

Days and times to be defined

Lessons from Monday to Friday, morning, afternoon or evening.

The course will take place in Trieste at the classrooms of the IAL FVG training institution in Via Pondares 5
