It's structured as a network on the Italian territory, thanks to its more than 130 subdivided offices, each with its own statutory autonomy but linked by common goals, values and mission with the main purpose of promoting and facilitating the full integration of foreign nationals through ensuring that they have equal access to services and enjoyment of rights as well as respect for duties.

The regional ANOLF FVG is part of the national ANOLF network and its activity consists in promoting dialogue, inclusion and participation of immigrant citizens, through the organization of initiatives in favor of mutual acquaintance, support and assistance in integration practices, accompaniment to services, and specific training courses as well as job placement.



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Training on labor market integration and employability

In October 2021, resuming the activity, we held several meetings with local partners and again analyzed the characteristics and needs of the territories. It was also agreed to select foreign people to be trained at the Regional Desk of "Orientation to the Cleaning Sector," promoted within the "axis of disadvantage" by SoForm (an accredited training agency in the Region) and intended for people referred by the Social Service of the Municipality of Pordenone and Trieste.

Thanks to this important path of integration, 14 women and 1 man were selected, who were accompanied in the training paths, enriching their skills necessary to actively enter the cleaning sector, in which the demand for personnel is significant.

The course took place in Pordenone from March to June for a total of 180 hours, 120 of which professionalizing and the remaining 60 designed to strengthen knowledge of the Italian language and active citizenship.

The project mainly targeted immigrant women, who in the labor market are the most fragile and at risk of marginalization. The synergies put in place with the UMN project, created the opportunity for these people to actively integrate into the labor market and subsequently be able to support their families and drop into the social network.



Agenda of the MLP

As part of the project, we implemented the exchange program (MLP) with the partner from Athens and Slovenia. In May, we organized, in addition to visits to reception centers, discussions in the form of a seminar and focus.

This MLP project came about with the intention of creating moments of encounter with various facilities dedicated to reception and integration, as well as providing support for migrants. By having to coordinate the various countries where the facilities are placed, this project has been a valuable help in comparing various situations, legislative differences and possible exchanges that will undoubtedly lead to improving the European vision on migrant policies, in light of the terrible events we are witnessing.


























































































































































Agenda of the MLP

From the comparisons, key points were determined as follows:

- Social cooperation alone cannot deal with all aspects of the reception and growth path of migrants and refugees, there is a need for other entities to cooperate together as well
- Work needs to be done on many fronts in training: language skills, vocational courses, safety education, rights training, even evening courses like the one at the Women's House in Trieste
- Essential to overcome the language barrier, also in function of 'access to employment
- Labor market: migrant citizens of working age in Italy are over 4 million, mostly young (in Trieste 50% are 18-25 years old) but lacking in professional skills
- Problem of inequality of immigrant women, there is an employment gap for migrant women due to economic and cognitive dependence, thus from both exogenous and endogenous factors (family structure)
- Housing reception system (social service) and second reception system, which includes a public service aimed at job
 placement, including with job grants (active internships)

- The system of large centers is contrasted with the system of widespread reception (a model pioneered in Trieste since 1998); in Trieste there are 180 apartments distributed throughout the city
- There is no univocal European policy on immigration, each country makes its own laws; in addition, active initiatives and policies are often regional
- Unaccompanied minors: literacy, training (especially on documents to stay in Italy, legality, knowledge of one's national/ethnic/religious affiliation) and involvement in activities, including play and informal activities.

Good Practice Actions.

- Sharing the good practices among different European countries
- Pursuing the goal of migrants/refugees acquiring an active social role
- Widespread reception model as an example for other European cities and countries as well
- Synergy between associations, unions and local authorities
- Training with courses even in the evenings

- The migrant emergency is still seen by institutions as a 'momentary' phenomenon, but it is not.

Support for the Ukrainian refugee emergency

Support for the Ukrainian refugee emergency under the UMN project.

As suggested by the Confederation of European Trade Union, with the partnership of UnionMigrantNet, we revised the project in order to give support to Italian families who hosted Ukrainian refugees by drawing from the UMN Project Fund.

We carried out two actions:

1. Administrative and bureaucratic support service and orientation at the Municipality of Trieste.

Anolf FVG wanted to continue with the planned activities also highlighting the coherence with the reading of the needs and requirements of Ukrainian users by activating once a week meetings with the offices of the Municipality of Trieste, through which they can access all the information about their legal status and receive assistance, support and advice for all practices, from the issuance and renewal of residence permits to 'humanitarian reception promoting the creation of governance networks with the active involvement of the various public bodies and relevant associations.













Support for the Ukrainian refugee emergency

2.S.O.S LINGUA - for teaching Italian L2 language and active citizenship.

In August, Anolf activated an intensive and free course in Italian language and active citizenship lasting 70 hours to give concrete support to private families who are offering hospitality to refugees from Ukraine as part of the UMN - UnionMigrantNet and CitiesTogether for Integration project.

The following people participated in the said course: a total of 49 people including 47 women age range from 20 to 70 and 3 minors age range: 12, 15 and 17. Also in parallel, we provided baby-sitting service to give the opportunities to include mothers who had children.












